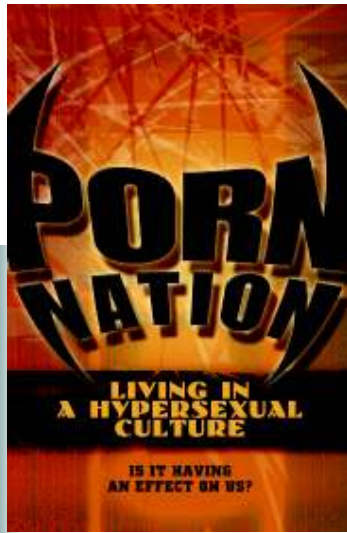
SPECIAL POINTS OF INTEREST:

It is one of THE big issues on campus. Pornography has become mainstream. With porn on the internet and cell phones it has become the perfect storm of addiction. It is available, affordable and anonymous. 87% of 17 to 18 year olds have been exposed to hard-core porn. An

entire generation is being trained with lies concerning the true nature of relationships and their bodies. In light of this we brought in Michael Leahy to present "Porn Nation." Michael is a believer who suffered the consequences of a life of porn addiction and ultimately adultery. After losing his business and his 15year marriage he found the Lord in the midst of his pain and need.

Now Michael travels the globe, often with CCC, to tell students his story, help them find freedom and share the gospel.

We had 450-500 students attend Porn Nation and felt great about how the program went. Michaels honesty and gentleness were well received by believers and nonbelievers alike. We had around 90 cards to follow-up after the event and 4 students indicated a decision to trust Christ.



Our students promote Porn Nation and ask students to write their opinion on our "What do you think of Porn?" easel. The answers were eye-opening and often saddening.

I had the chance to meet with one of the students that made

that decision, Tom (name changed) and we have really connected. When I asked him if he wanted to get together for a coke and talk he said yes and asked if he could bring his girlfriend. After just a few minutes of chatting Tom told me of their constant fight-

ing over sex and how things became tough for them as a couple after he slept with her friends girlfriend! Amazing, their openness and honesty were refreshing, but their need and struggle were right out front as well. We talked for an hour about relationships, places where they identified with the speaker and confusion and hurt they had around Christianity. They wanted to meet again and

now we have met 3 out of the last 4 weeks. Over the Halloween week we discussed ghosts, rock music, illusionists, American Idol and eventually more scripture. At one point Lucy (name changed), the girlfriend, asked me if I thought it was hard or easy to get into heaven, Wow! We looked at Romans 10:9-10, John 5:24 and 1 John 5. The Lord is working in their life and it has been a joy to be there while it's happening.

Here is an email from an attendee, a catholic nun on campus that is at KU but originally from Italy.

"Dear Mark,
Thank you for your effort to bring a good speaker on Campus! I really admire your courage and your creativity. I think that the Lord needs a lot of people who are able to organize something like that in a place where students are. This is so good! You are like Jesus, who goes where people are, and doesn't just wait in the temple or in the synagogue. You bring the Good News to KU. You preach to the crowd, not just to... the choir. "Go quickly into the streets and alleys of the town and bring in here the poor and the crippled..." (Lk, 14, 21). You do what Jesus did. I pray God may always bless your ministry.
