PRAYER REQUESTS

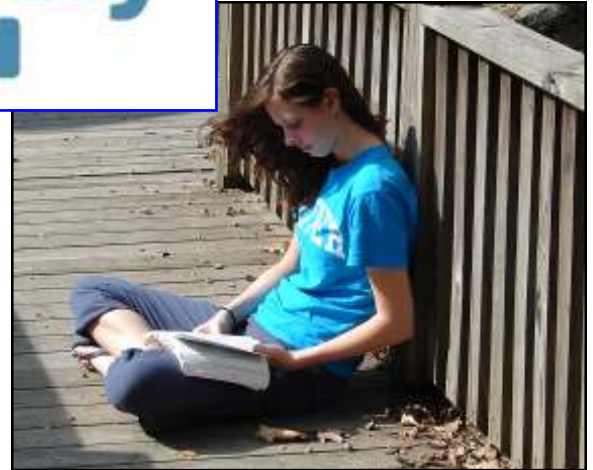
- > Follow-up from our Porn Nation event (more about that next month). We have several new students involved from the event and we want to do an excellent job in reaching out to others in Christ.
